OUR CURRICULUM

Loose parts, innovations to play and purposeful interactions with trusted and supportive adults will enable our youngest learners to thrive in an environment and curriculum designed and purposefully built with their development at the heart. Nursery Sessions

The Nursery at Bengeworth CE Academy warmly welcomes children from the age of 3 years old and provides childcare Monday to Friday from 7.45am-6pm during term-time only. With Wraparound Care providing childcare from 7.45am-6pm. Our rolling start and finish times will enable parents with children already at Bengeworth CE Academy to stop off and collect within the school's drop off and collection windows. All Nursery sessions include a nutritious snack and drink.

Fees and Wraparound Care

Children aged 3 or over will be entitled to Early Years Education Entitlement Funding (15hr funding), beginning from the start of the term **after** their 3rd birthday and you may be eligible for an additional 15 hours funding.

15 or 30 hour funding can be used to pay for sessions your child attends. Our lunchtime session and Wraparound Care are charged separately.
