


#### RAGS2RICHES

Night Owls' After School Care is provided at our Burford Road setting for children from the end of the school day until 6.00pm, Monday to Friday during term time

The club is supervised by experienced members of Bengeworth staff who provide children with an enjoyable and sociable experience at the end of the school day. Children in Reception and Year One are accompanied to the club by a member of staff at 3pm. Children in Years Two to Five who finish the school day at 3.15pm are accompanied by a member of Night Owls' team from King's Road to Burford Road. A walk-down service is also provided for children who attend any after school Curriculum+ clubs and whose parents need ongoing childcare beyond 4.00/4.15pm.
