Late Reminder



Our school day runs from 8.45am until 3.15pm, with a collection at 3.00pm at Burford Road to enable parents with siblings to travel between settings. If your child arrives after registration, they will be marked as absent, and we ask that parents inform the school of the reason for their lateness. Thank you.

We politely ask that parents do not arrive earlier than 8.30am and no later than 8.45am. Families arriving after 8.45am will be asked to register their child as late via the main school office, this is to ease congestion for our Reception class in the Nursery outdoor area.

School Uniform

We would like to kindly remind you of our school's expectations regarding hairstyles and jewellery to ensure all children maintain a neat and tidy appearance while at school.

Hairstyles

must be of a conventional nature. No tram-lines or shaved hair. Long hair should be tied back away from the face at all times using hair bands/slides in the school colours (black/grey/red). Only small hairbands should be worn in the hair (no large adornments).

Jewellery

Small studs worn in pierced ears are the only acceptable items of jewellery. For safety reasons, hooped or dangling earrings must not be worn. Stud earrings must be removed before P.E. lessons. Nail varnish and tattoos are not permitted.
