Book & Bake

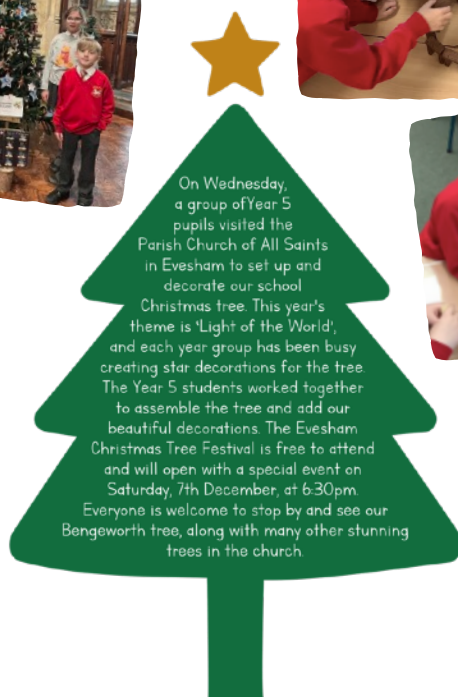
