Year 1 Visit the Church

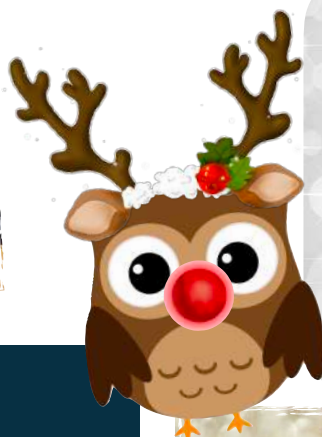
